2012 PLAN FOR SUCCESSFUL ORGANIC GROWTH

PRIORITY #1 ON BLOCK A

Area between Block A open pit resource (M-Zone) and the underground QK Zone discovered by Placer Dome in mid-90's

- Drilling program of 50,000 m in H1 2012
- Start pre-feasibility study for small open pit (Block A resource)
- Advance exploration of QK underground zone

PRIORITY #2 ON LOWER DETOUR DEFORMATION ZONE (+40 KM)

- Follow up on prior high-grade gold mineralized drill hole intercepts (53 g/t Au over 3 m)
- 20,000 m of diamond drilling along a 5 km corridor
- IP geophysical survey on the remaining belt
